

How to get to Aegina island?

Our courses take place on Aegina Island (pronounced as "Egina"), off the coast of Athens. After landing at Athens Airport, it will take about two to three hours of travel (one hour by taxi and one hour by ferry plus your connection times) to reach your blue and sunny destination!

Airport to Piraeus

Taxi

The taxi fee is **€55** and will take 45-60min. You can ask for "ferry port" and "Saronikos ferries" and your driver will always understand. There might be an additional fee for early mornings and late evenings transfers.

Metro

You can grab **Metro Line 3** opposite of the terminal and will bring you to "Piraeus Station" (one stop before terminus). A public transport ticket costs €6 and is valid for 24hours.

Bus

You can take the bus X95 to Athens central and **bus X96 to Piraeus** port. The bus runs all day, approximately every 20min and the journey will take just over an hour depending on traffic. A public transport ticket costs €6 and is valid for 24hours.



Arranging Flights

You should book flights to **Athens International Airport** (Eleftherios Venizelos) and from the airport, you will need to transfer to **Piraeus**, the main port of Athens.

Flying on your course day? Make sure to land no later than 3pm. Flying a day prior to your course? Sleep in Athens or Aegina and enjoy sight-seeing!

On your way back: You will need to disembark the yacht on Friday at 5pm. This is in time for you to be back at the airport for 7:30pm. If you sleep one extra night in Aegina, choose a return flight no earlier than 1pm (due to the ferry schedule).

You can travel to Piraeus by taxi, metro, or bus. See left column.

At Piraeus Port

You will need to go to **GATE E8** for the ferries and "fast-ferries" to the **Saronic Islands**. Taxi drivers will drop you at the right spot for your ferry. By bus and metro you will have to walk a few minutes to reach the gate. Tickets booths are along the harbour. You can also pre-book your tickets online, but might still have to pass a booth to collect them.

Ferries for Aegina

You will need to reach **Aegina Town**. Most ferries cross in 1h15min but you can also catch a fast-ferry which takes 40min for a slightly higher price. You can check the **Openseas** website www.openseas.gr for all schedules (only a few weeks ahead displayed). You might need to pre-book for busy times (Friday and Saturday evenings).
